- Be **PROUD** to be part of an inclusive club offering Athletics to everyone.
- Show **ENTHUSIASM** for Athletics and the C&C Athletes.
- Enjoy working **COLLABORATIVELY** and **SHARING** ideas and good practice with other volunteers.
- Enjoy **CHAIRING** and supporting and developing the club to thrive locally and nationally.

The basic aim of the Chairperson is to...

- **Maintain** the club – working with other members and groups to keep the club in running order
- **Develop** the club – cultivate links with external bodies to get the best for the club's athletes with support from other club members and groups
